
When creating a report, the questionnaire will guide you through required questions step by step.

 - 1.2.1 The injured party reported that no rescue services attended the accident scene.
 - 1.3 AFTER THE ACCIDENT**
 - 1.3.1 Mr Test1 was able to exit the vehicle without assistance. After the accident the injured party continued his journey.
